



BNSC PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES AND CODE OF CONDUCT

Players participating in BNSC programs are exercising a privilege afforded to them by their parents, team, club and BNSC. As a BNSC player, you have the following responsibilities and agree to abide by the rules of the BNSC:

General guidelines:

- *Players are expected to conduct themselves at all times in a manner that will not bring discredit upon BNSC.*
- *Respect for property of others, adherence to the rules and guidelines as specified here and in BNSC's rules and regulations handbook, or by a Coach/Administrator, and observance of State and Federal laws are required for participation in this program.*
- *Players will not be allowed to drive themselves to any BNSC event outside the Boise metro-plex.*

Discipline Rules:

- *Substance abuse and/or possession thereof – drugs, alcohol, and/or tobacco (by minors) is cause for immediate dismissal from the program.*
- *Persistent irresponsible and disrespectful behavior is cause for dismissal from the program.*
- *Destruction of property or violation of State and Federal laws is cause for dismissal from the program.*

Responsibility:

It is the Coach's duty to suspend any player found to be in violation of the above rules and to notify BNSC within three days of the incident. A disciplinary committee will review the violation in a timely manner. Failure to notify BNSC may result in a sanction against all involved including the team and/or club.
